

Flying Pig Marathon 2011 Corrals/Pig Pens

Based upon runner feedback and with a goal to improve the race day experience for all participants, the Flying Pig Marathon will be instituting corrals, or “Pig Pens,” for the 2011 race. Each runner will be asked to submit an expected finish time upon registering. That expected time will determine which of the five Pig Pens the participant will be placed in at the start line.

The assigned Pig Pen will be indicated on each participant’s race bib with both a color and a letter. Our Pig Pens will be structured as follows:

	Color	Full Marathon Projected Finish	Half Marathon Projected Finish
Pig Pen A	Black	3:29 and faster	1:44 and faster
Pig Pen B	Red	3:30 – 3:59	1:45 – 1:59
Pig Pen C	Light Purple	4:00 – 4:29	2:00 – 2:14
Pig Pen D	Orange	4:30 – 5:00	2:15 – 2:30
Pig Pen E	Pink	5:01+	2:30+

The color and letter scheme will be reflected in the corresponding signage indicating each Pig Pen’s entrance. Entrances will be accessed at the rear of each corral by using the sidewalks on either side of Mehring Way which will only be open to participants. Pig Pen entrances will be monitored and correct placement will be enforced. Portable restrooms will be located in each corral.

On race day, participants will not be able to move forward to another corral. However, they will be permitted to move backwards if they feel that is a better option for them or would like to start with another participant. If a participant would like to move up a corral because they think their estimated finish time will be better, please visit the Pig Pen/Corral Assignment Booth at the Expo during packet pick-up.

This is our first year for utilizing Pig Pens. Please allow extra time to find and position yourself in the correct Pig Pen. Late arriving participants will not be guaranteed placement their correct Pig Pen.
